Pilot license third country CONVERSION - medical part

If you want to convert your pilot's license from a third country into an EU license, it is important to note that the corresponding EU medical certificate must accompany the EU pilot's license.

If you have or had an EU-issued medical certificate, you must submit MED-FRM-008 to transfer medical documentation. Find the form at the bottom of <https://www.ccaa.hr/en/forms-72237>.

If you do not have an EU medical certificate, or it has expired more than 5 years ago, take an initial examination for the relevant class. Class 1 exams must be at an EU Aero-medical Centre (AeMC). Find a list of Croatian AeMCs at <https://www.ccaa.hr/en/aero-medical-centres-and-examiners-aemcs-68747>.

The initial medical examination can also be performed in another EU member state. Tell the AeMC/AME that Croatia will issue your pilot license. The AeMC will then send your records to CCAA, whose medical assessor will confirm compliance of your medical certificate as part of the conversion procedure.

Remark

The transfer process may take longer due to slow data exchange. Be patient. Always check with your home authority about fees for transferring medical or pilot license documentation.

Also, keep in mind that additional tests or consultations may be required during the initial examination, so do not wait until the last minute before your skills test or license issuance. Schedule your medical appointment early.
